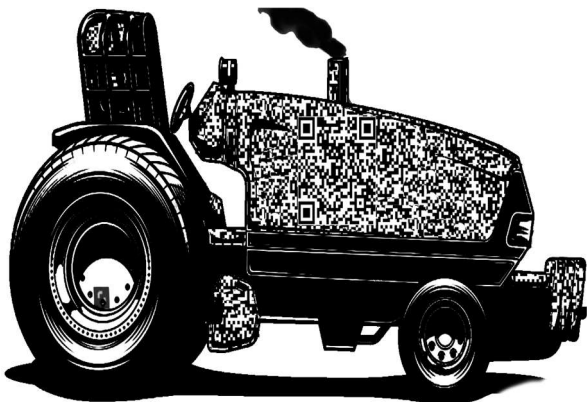

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. No Alcohol on Premises - NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 2. 20" Drawbar limit Measured On Scales To Top of Drawbar.**
- 3. No Turn Buckles or Top Link Hooked above the center of axle. Drawbar must be 18 inches from center of axle to hook point of drawbar and stationary.**
- 4. No One Allowed On Track Except Drivers and Judges.**
- 5. Tractors Must Be Farm Stock.**
- 6. All 4-Wheel Drives Must Drop Front Shaft.**
- 7. No Jerks Of The Sled, Both Chains Must Be Tight Before Pulling.**
- 8. Tractors Are To Be in Neutral Before Hooked To Sled.**
- 9. Tractors Must Be Ready To Pull or Pass (limit 2 Minute).**
- 10. Tractor Can Pass Position If They Have An Obvious Break Down And Pull At The End, Then They Will Fall Back Into Rotation.**
- 11. No One Except Drivers On Tractors At Anytime.**
- 12. Winners Of Each Class Must Be Re-Weighed (if Judges request).**
- 13. Tractor going over lines, items falling off or overpull is a dq, this will apply till tractor is unhooked from sled.**
- 14. Each Driver Draws Own Number. Must give tractor on each draw of number.**
- 15. All Drivers Must Be 12 Years of Age or Older and Able to Control Tractor.**
- 16. Only One Place Paid Per Tractor. Tractor Cannot Get % and Heavy Load Both.**
- 17. Each Driver Must Furnish Their Own Clevis and Hooker. If using a clevis must be parallel to drawbar. [no modified Clevis]**
- 18. Once Drivers Has Pulled They Cannot Pass.**
- 19. Sled Will Travel In One Direction Only Until Reaching The End Of the Track [measured by sled].**
- 20. All Drivers Must Stay In Their Seats While Pulling.**
- 21. All Decisions By Judges Are Final NO EXCEPTIONS.[ can ask to re-weigh placing tractors]**
- 22. Tractor weight will break on 500 lbs.**
- 23. Tractors must have wheelie bars. They will measure no more than 12 inches from the ground at the farthest most point of the rear tire. They must also be able to support weight of tractor.**
- 24. Front weight bracket can be no more than 11 feet from Center of rear axle to most forward part of weights.**
- 25. Over pull chain 3 ft on 3500 to 6000 and 5 ft on 6000 to 9000**
- 26. Tire size maximum is 18.4 except 9000 and heavier.**
